Autism

Centered around evidence-based practices, our autism services connect families with programs that make a difference. Our Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services provide 1:1 and group therapy in a clinic setting that incorporates parent training and skills transfer along with collaborative speech, occupational, and physical therapies.



Every student learns differently, so our educational programs fit a variety of needs. Students within The Day School enjoy the highest quality education from ages 5-21, along with transition and therapy services, state-ofthe-art classroom technology, and a variety of facilities to meet their needs.



By developing skills to manage mood, thinking, and behaviors, kids make the move toward resiliency and healing to become happier and healthier. With both in-person and telehealth options available for individual, family, and group therapy, along with medication management and parent education, our team builds individualized therapy plans to foster growth.



With permanency as a focus, our services nurture, support, and maintain the family so all amazing kids can grow in a safe, healthy, and loving environment. Most of our services require county referrals for participation. Our in-home family services, visit coaching, SWAN services, infant parent empowerment program, and care coordination services help to empower the entire family.

Physical, occupational, and speech therapies, along with hearing, vision, nutrition, developmental, and social work services, are provided in the home at no cost to families.
